### In Class Procedure at a Glance

**PART A**

1. Hand out first 2 pages. Get students to form questions, checking with their partners. Then correct around class (write answers on board).
2. Students interview Teacher to make sure everybody knows what to do.
3. Now divide students into pairs: Student A & Student B. Student A interviews Student B and writes answers on photocopy. Then vice-versa.
4. Now Student A has to 'stand up and move one place to the right'. They now interview the new Student B. And vice versa.
5. Ditto with the rest of the students.

## PART B

1. Teacher has to compile all info and put it in a results table (page 3 shows a template with 2 example students' answers). Then write about 15-20 questions based on results (page 4 shows an example of this).
2. Give out completed results table. Ask students to check that the information is correct.
3. Now give out the Questions (page 4). Students do this individually.
4. Then check with partners.
5. Correct around class, writing answers on board.
