Interview two people. Ask them the following questions and write down their answers.

Do you like going shopping? Why?		
Do you think food is expensive in Ireland?		
Are the shops in Ireland different from the shops in your country? How?		
Do you sometimes go to shops in Ireland that sell food from your country? Where are the shops?

In Class Procedure at a Glance

Distribute questionnaires – one per student.

Ask students to interview one person by asking the questions from the questionnaire. Write the answers in the second column.

Students then interview another student and write their answers in the third column.

Discuss findings with the class.
