CLASS SURVEY – Teacher's notes

- 1. Ask learners about their transport habits. Ask or elicit the question 'How do you come to class?'. Many of the other questions in the worksheet should come up naturally in the course of the class discussion.**
- 2. Give out one worksheet per learner. Draw attention to the 8 questions. Ask learners to fill in the gaps in pairs or alone. Check through answers with entire class.**
- 3. Ask learners to fold their page along the dotted line and look at the survey table only.**
- 4. Whole class now asks the teacher the 8 questions from exercise using only the prompts on the survey table. Correct and practise questions.**
- 5. Learners mingle to survey classmates.**
- 6. (Optional) Results table can be drawn on board and filled in by learners asking the 8 questions about one another to extend to third person questions. 'How does Anna come to class?', etc.**
- 7. Class discussion on transport in Ireland.**
